AFTD Volunteer Opportunities

Community Outreach/ Awareness	Table Settings	Find opportunities and represent AFTD at community events, conferences, etc.
	Meet & Greets	Plan and facilitate an informal gathering to bring together people whose lives have been touched by FTD
	Facility Outreach	Conduct awareness facility visits during the regular work day
	Media Coverage	Initiate contact with radio stations and newspapers; participate in interviews for FTD and AFTD awareness
Support Group Facilitator	Face to Face Groups	Organize and facilitate an in-person FTD caregiver support group (professional experience not required)
	Phone Groups	Facilitate a phone-based FTD caregiver support group (professional experience not required)
Coordinating/ Leading Volunteers	Regional Coordinator Volunteer	Provide guidance and support to volunteers in region; represent AFTD
	Food for Thought Liaison	Support other AFTD volunteers to convene food-based fundraising events
Fundraising	Food for Thought Campaign	Plan and organize a fundraising event in local community during the campaign (late September/early October)
	With Love Campaign	Create a fundraising page for this online campaign (every February)
	Runs/Walks	Organize an AFTD team for an already established community walk/run event; if not a runner, assist at AFTD table on race day
	Independent Events	Plan and execute your own fundraiser
Help AFTD at Its Office	Assist with Mailings and Other Efforts	Assist staff in our Radnor, PA office
